DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Lavatories, splash board, walls, stalls, doors: Great for cleaning basins, tubs, and tiles. Leaves everything bright and clean. Odors disappear instantly. Use where odors are a problem. Spray full strength into a wet sponge or cloth. Wipe on, rinse and let air dry.

FLOORS: Use anywhere greasy dirt is a problem. Dilute 1 part cleaner to 10 parts water. For heavy soil accumulation, dilute 1 part cleaner to 6 parts water.

For extremely heavy soil accumulation on floors: Increase the cleaning use dilution to as much as 2 quarts to the gallon.

TOILET BOWLS: Remove or expel over the inner trap residual bowl water prior to applying use solution. Use 4 ounces of concentrate in bowl. Squeeze around bowl and under rim, then scrub thoroughly with brush. This product when used as directed will not harm white or colored bowls or inanimate hard surfaces. Use full strength. Swab all porcelain and brightwork as well as seat or cover surface and flush box. Rinse and air dry. Close cap on container after use.

URINALS: Add 4 ounces of concentrate, then scrub thoroughly with brush.
