PEROXY-BRITE

Non-Chlorinated, Oxygen-Based Bleach



PRODUCT INFORMATION:

Safe to use on most all-machine-washable fabrics and colors.
Powerful enough to remove even the toughest stains.

NOTE: Do not allow Peroxy Brite to dry on fabric. This can lead to fiber damage of the garment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

DO NOT MIX WITH OTHER CHEMICALS.

Some individuals may be sensitive to ingredients in this product. Before use, read product label and SDS sheet. If questions remain, consult your employer or a physician.

As a Laundry Bleach:

1. Always read and follow care directions.
2. If the care label on a garment states "no bleach," do not attempt to use Peroxy Brite without first testing an inconspicuous area on the garment.
3. Sort laundry by color and fabric type.
4. From care directions, choose proper wash cycle and water temperature.
5. Do not overload washer with soiled laundry.
6. If using a metering system: Add 6 – 10 oz. of Peroxy Brite per 100 lbs. of dry laundry, depending on soil load and stain type. For manual addition: Add 1/2 to 1 cup (4 – 8 oz.) of Peroxy Brite per 100 lbs. of dry laundry, depending on soil load and stain type.

As a Laundry Pre-Soak:

1. Sort laundry by color and fabric type.
2. Add 5 – 7 oz. of Peroxy Brite to 5 gallons of water, using the hottest water recommended from the care directions.
3. Pre-soak garments.
 - a. For bright and dark colors, pre-soak for 15 – 45 minutes.
 - b. For whites and light colors, pre-soak for 1 – 6 hours.
4. Wash as usual

As a Laundry Stain Pre-Treatment:

1. Apply a small amount of Peroxy Brite directly to the stain as soon as possible.
2. Gently rub the stain and allow Peroxy Brite to penetrate the stain for 3 – 5 minutes.
3. Wash pre-treated garment immediately.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION:
