DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Most conventional glass cleaners are made with solvents, alcohols (toxic, and typically poisonous), ammonia (a respiratory irritant), or ethylene-based glycol ethers (toxic, and not readily biodegradable). Unlike these cleaning products, this product does not have any unpleasant chemical smell or leave a residue.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Spray on to any glass surface. Dry and polish with soft, lint-free cloth.

NOTE: Best results can be obtained using two cloths: one for drying and one for polishing.

IMPORTANT: Always test surface in an inconspicuous area prior to use. DO NOT USE ON FURNITURE.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION:
