DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Designed for use in frozen food lockers with temperatures near 10°F range. Can be applied by brush, mops, spray equipment or floor scrubbing machines. Use full strength. Do not dilute with water. Cleaned surfaces can be wiped dry with clean rags, wiping cloths or paper towels.

HAND CLEANING WALLS AND RACKS: Use product full strength. Apply with brush, mop or spray equipment. Cleaned surfaces can be wiped dry with clean towels or wiping cloths.

FLOORS AND SMALL FREEZER AREAS: Can be hand cleaned using floor mops and brushes. Apply full strength to clean. Pick up dirty solutions with dry mops. Use separate buckets for clean product and dirty pick-up solutions.

MACHINE FLOOR SCRUBBERS: Use product full strength. Apply to floor with scrubbing action and pick up the dirty solution to recovery tank. Work quickly.
