DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Some individuals may be sensitive to ingredients in this product. Before use, read product label and Safety Data Sheet.

- 1. Sort laundry by color and fabric type.
- 2. Always read and follow care directions.
- 3. From care directions, choose proper wash cycle and water temperature.
- 4. Do not overload washer with soiled laundry.
- 5. Add Clothesline Fresh Enzyme Laundry Detergent.
- a. Top Load Washers: Use 1/16 to 1/8 cup, or 0.5 to 1 oz., depending on soil load.

For excessively high soil loads, use $1\!\!/_{\!\!4}$ cup or 2 oz.

- b. Front Load Washers: Use 1/8 to $\frac{1}{4}$ cup, or 1 to 2 oz. per 50 lbs. of dry soiled laundry.
- c. For heavily stained linen, apply Power Burst directly on the stain and allow it to dwell on the fabric before laundering. NOTE: Optimal water temperature for enzymatic activity is 70°F 150°F.
